### **RLT PRESENTS KIDWORKS 'WELCOME TO THE 60's'**

#### **More Than 30 Children Involved In Revue May 21-22**

ROGERS, Ark. — Dig out your go-go boots and peace signs while Rogers Little Theater's talented youth perform a revue called 'Welcome to the 60's,' May 21-22.

More than 30 children from the KidWorks program classes will be in the spotlight, performing a variety of songs like "The Age of Aquarius" to a Brady Bunch remix.

"Join in a night of great fun for the entire family. You'll leave with a smile on your face and a 60's song in your heart," said Martina Peacock, KidWorks director.

RLT KidWorks classes take place at RLT's Spotlight Studio, 204 W. Walnut, in Rogers, and are for children as young as 6 years old through the teenage years who want to be on stage and experience the thrill of performing for an audience.

Peacock works with Instructor Dru Peacock-Wiser to create themed shows for KidWorks classes as well as RLT KidWorks summer camps.

Signups are taking place now for the Musical Theater Camps scheduled for June and July.

The Musical Theater Camps focus on Broadway numbers and themes. RLT is offering two completely different camps, with each camp session lasting two weeks and ending with two performances on the RLT Victory Theater stage.

The "Broadway Blast" camp sessions I and II engage kids 6-16 years olds who are interested in acting, dancing and singing in an upbeat and positive environment. Production numbers are from well-loved Broadway musicals like Peter Pan, Annie, Hairspray and many more. The two performances at the end of each camp are complete with lights, microphones and costumes. This program is designed to develop stage performance and build self-esteem in a fun atmosphere. Each "Broadway Blast" session costs \$150, and will take place Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m. to noon, with night performances Friday and Saturday.

"Broadway Babies" camp sessions I and II are new this year, by popular demand, and are for ages 4-5. An experienced instructor with many years of experience working with this age group will encourage these youngest ones to use their creativity and to take their imaginations to the stage during the end-of camp performances. Each "Broadway Babies" session costs \$75, and will take place Monday-Friday, 2-3:30 p.m., with night performances Friday and Saturday.

Families that purchase 2 or more sessions or enroll two or more of their children receive a 10 percent discount. Payment for discounts must be made at the RLT Box Office.
